FEWER AMERICANS ARE CUTTING BACK ON TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES

As gas prices started to fall in September, fewer respondents report having to cut back on transportation costs. In June, 32% of respondents cut back on gas & transportation costs, and in September only 22% had.






INFLATION IS STILL IMPACTING FINANCIAL DECISIONS

- 26% say that they have stopped dining out regularly
- 24% say that they have stopped buying high-priced grocery items, like premium meat/seafood and organic produce

CONFIDENCE IN THE U.S. ECONOMY IS RISING

In September 2022, 28% of respondents said they were "somewhat confident" in the U.S. economy, compared to only 19% in June.





HAS THE COST OF BASIC NECESSITIES HAD AN IMPACT ON YOUR LIFESTYLE?

Fewer respondents in September reported that the cost of basic necessities had a cost on their family's lifestyle. In June, 48% of respondents said that the cost of basic necessities had a "significant impact" on their lifestyle, compared to only 42% in September.
